



Affiliated Researchers

Future Forum is recruiting highly qualified candidates in various fields of expertise for inclusion on our roster of Affiliated Researchers. Affiliated Researchers are not staff; Future Forum will occasionally contract out work to individuals on the roster, based on needs and the expertise of individuals on the roster. There is no contractual obligation on either Future Forum to provide any remunerated work to roster members or roster members to accept work.

Future Forum is looking for people with specific expertise in the following fields: economics, political science, digital economy, legal affairs/law, statistics, urban planning, demographics, market research, public opinion polling. Journalists and/or individuals with strong proven research and writing skills will also be considered.

Examples of work Affiliated Researchers may be contracted to do include:

- Independent research and analysis into the aforementioned topics, including the formulation of public policy recommendations;
- Political analysis and risk assessments;
- Scenario planning/foresighting; and
- Workshops/trainings.

Requirements

- At a minimum, an MA/post-graduate degree in political science, international relations/affairs, economics/political economy, public policy, development or related fields; candidates with a BA/undergraduate degree will be considered if supplemented by exceptional prior work experience;
- Previous work experience related to conducting research and analysis;
- Strong interest in Southeast Asia, Cambodia and Cambodian politics and policy issues; candidates with prior experience in Cambodia will be given priority;
- Fluency in English (reading, writing and speaking);
- Strong communication skills, both written and verbal;
- Background in research (quantitative and/or qualitative) and/or statistical analysis skills preferred;

Other Information

- Future Forum is based in Phnom Penh, Cambodia; candidates based in the country will be given higher priority;
- Remuneration for contracted work will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis and determined based on a Researcher's prior experience and expertise;

Application Procedure

Interested candidates should submit their CV/Resume, a cover letter, an unedited writing sample (such as academic papers, research reports, policy briefing notes or published media work) and contact information for three references to info@futureforum.asia. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted. Future Forum will thoroughly screen, interview and verify stated previous experience for each applicant prior inclusion on the roster. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis until we have ten (10) people on the roster.
